Subramaniam Presents 3-Crore Deficit Budget

MADRAS, Feb. 26.

A flat surcharge of two annas in the rupee on Land Revenue on all lands, wet, dry and garden, and on all water rates, is proposed in the budget for 1955-56, presented to the Madras Assembly today by Mr. C. Subramaniam, Finance Minister.

PRESENTING a deficit budget of Rs. 331 lakhs, the Finance Minister also proposed levy of general sales tax on tobacco and all its derivatives, excepting superior manufactured tobacco (which is already subject to a higher tax) and a five per cent tax on turnover at a single point on cigarettes costing less than

3 pies each.

The Minister also announced tax reliefs, costing about Rs. 10
lakis, in the form of exemption from sales tax to: (a) onions, potatoes, befel leaves and plantain leaves, (b) palm gur produced by cooperative societies, and (c) products of Ottage Industrial Co-operative Societies, like carpets, poss, stoneware, brassware, toys, etc.
